- Department of Economic Development staff have created a timeline to ensure the renewal and contract are in place to ensure no lapse in service.



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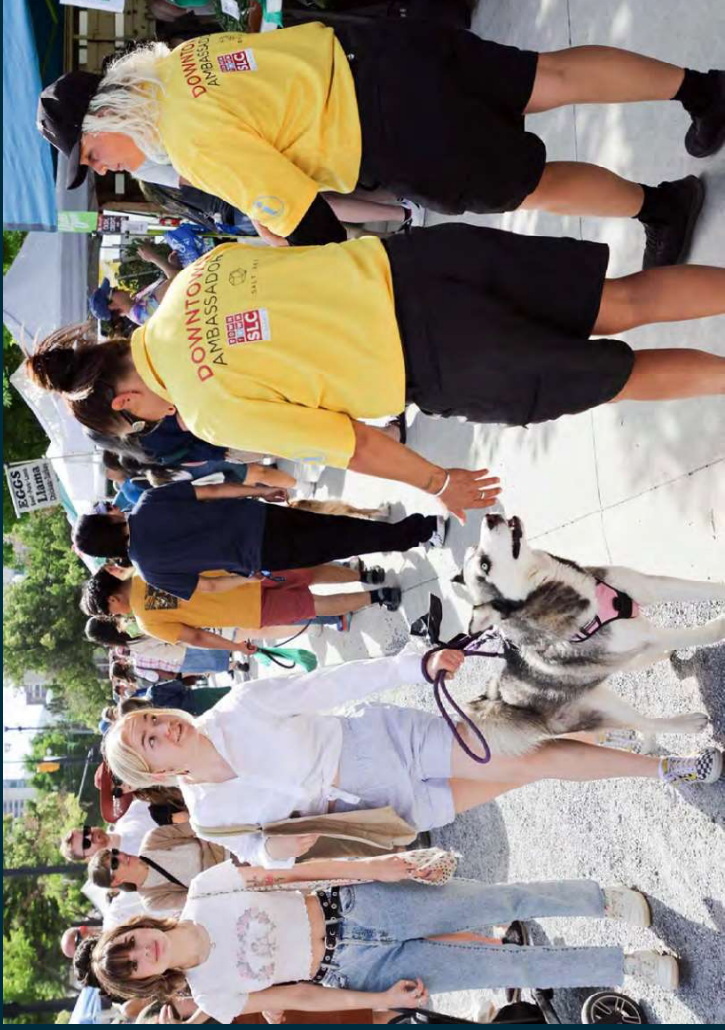

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# SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ACTIONS

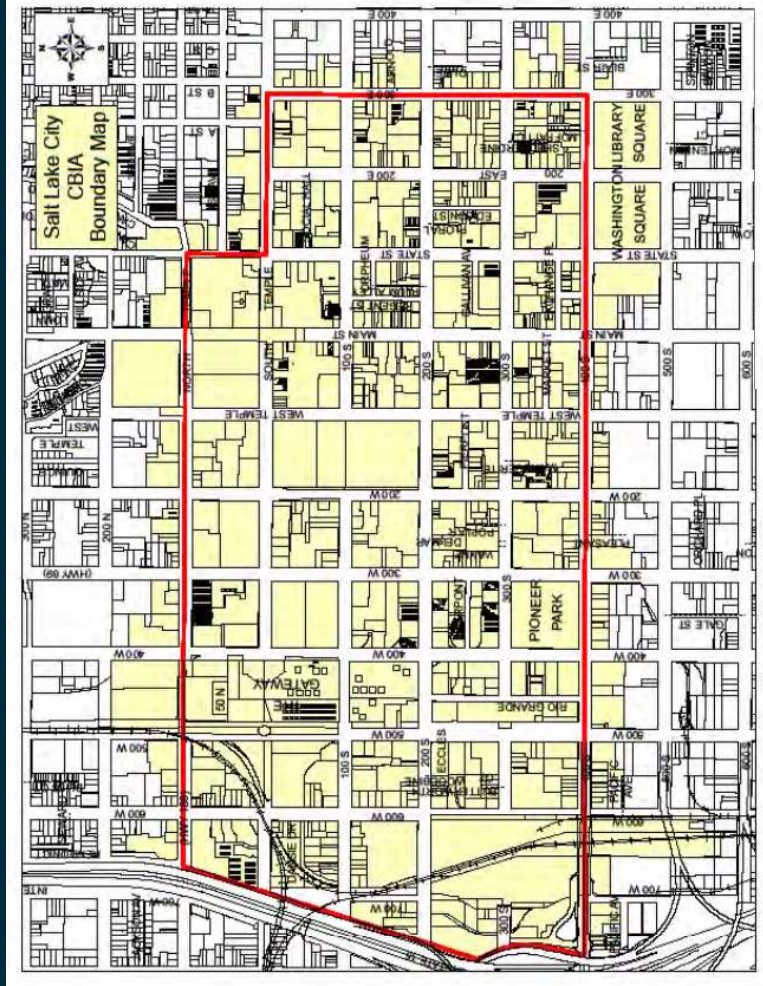
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- July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024– City Council reviewed a transmittal of the Resolution of Intention to Designate the CBIA as a special assessment area
- July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024 – City Council voted to adopt the above resolution
- September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024 – City Council Protest Hearing
- November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024 – City Council announced protest tally
- November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024 – City Council adopted the Resolution to Designate the Assessment Area and appoint the Board of Equalization
- February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025 – Staff Memo updating Council on timeline extension
- April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 – City Council to vote on the Assessment Ordinance and Board of Equalization recommendations



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# CBIA-25 BOUNDARY MAP

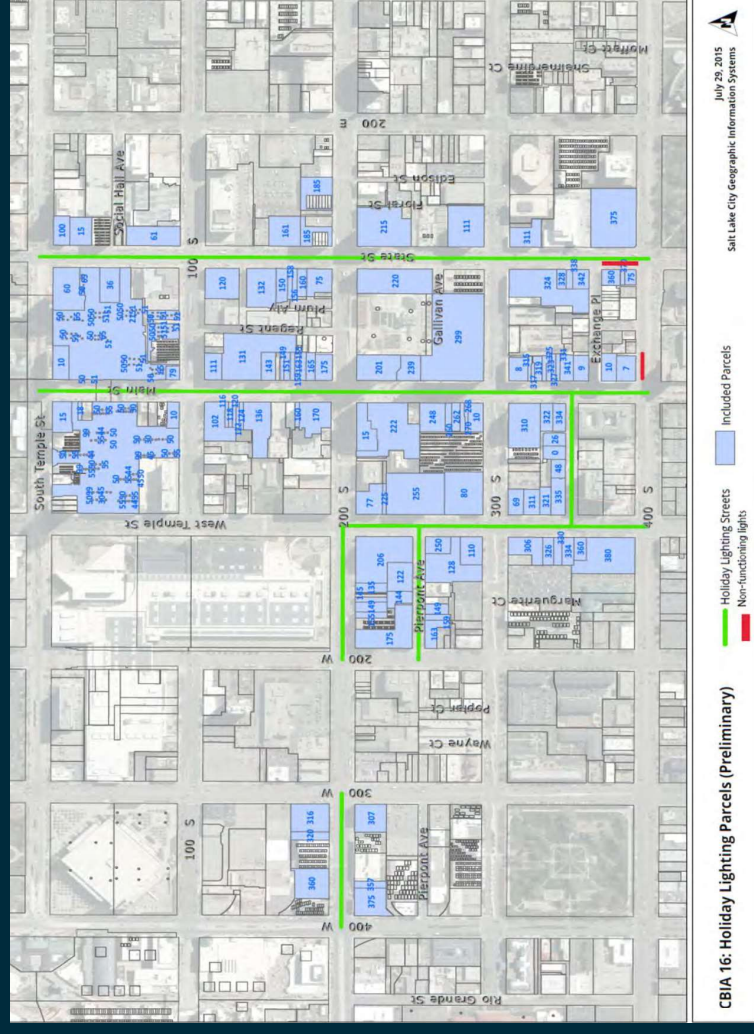


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# CBIA-25 LIGHTING ASSESSMENT BOUNDARIES
