GRANT DETAILS:

This project studies refinements to South Temple, a nationally recognized Great Street by the American Planning Association. South Temple was once a gem of Salt Lake City –serving as a transportation corridor and promenade between downtown and the University of Utah. South Temple’s increasing domination by automobile traffic detracts from the historic architecture lining the street and creates new safety concerns for people walking and bicycling. Special consideration will be given to improving crossings and clearer rights-of-way at offset intersections between the Avenues neighborhood and areas to the south. South Temple’s role in the Green Loop will also be evaluated.
