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

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2nd Tranche Requests per Administration's April 21, 2025 Transmittal

Requests, for the Council to approve...

- Project costs and scopes (p. 8 of the transmittal)
- Changes to bond-funded personnel funding and positions in the Public Lands Department and the Arts Council (p. 5-6)
- The 2nd Tranche total of \$34,986,400 before June 17, 2025, so that the Finance Department can include these items and budgets in their summer 2025 transmittal for the Council to authorize the bond parameters and sale (p. 4)

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Tentative Schedule

Finance Dept / Treasurer's Office

- June 17, 2025 – Council adopts the FY26 budget, including authorization for funding from the 2nd Tranche of the Parks GO Bond to be spent after bond closing
- July 1 – Bond transaction briefing by the Finance Dept / Treasurer's Office
- July 8 – Council adopts Bond Parameters Resolution
- Oct 9 – Bond closing; appropriations can be used



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
