GRANT DETAILS:

UCORE funding will supplement the Park Rangers' educational programming supplies budget. The Park Rangers are developing a wide range of educational programs for the public, especially youth, to enjoy. The more supplies available, the more programs can be delivered. Thus far, most of the programming has taken place on the west side of Salt Lake City. These neighborhoods have tremendous access to parks and trails but have historically been underinvested in from a recreation and programming perspective. That has changed in recent years, and the Park Rangers' educational programming wants to continue that positive momentum by engaging more youth in the outdoor spaces in their neighborhood. The goal on the west side, and across the city, is to nurture a sense of belonging and stewardship of their communities' open space. Supplies include art supplies, programming equipment, sporting equipment, animal habitats, Junior Rangers supplies, and other educational materials.
