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# Salt Lake City Safety & Security Plan

- Issue: Shortage of 1000-1600 year-round emergency shelter beds
- Immediate: Expedite creation of additional shelter beds through a temporary, interim emergency shelter program
- Short-Term: State Legislature identify and allocate stable & dedicated funding for homeless, behavioral health and housing services
- State Legislature consider requiring all counties to provide emergency shelter and housing services proportional to their needs
- Long-Term: OHS should lead request for additional operating and capital funds for FY'27 towards opening campus as soon as FY'28
