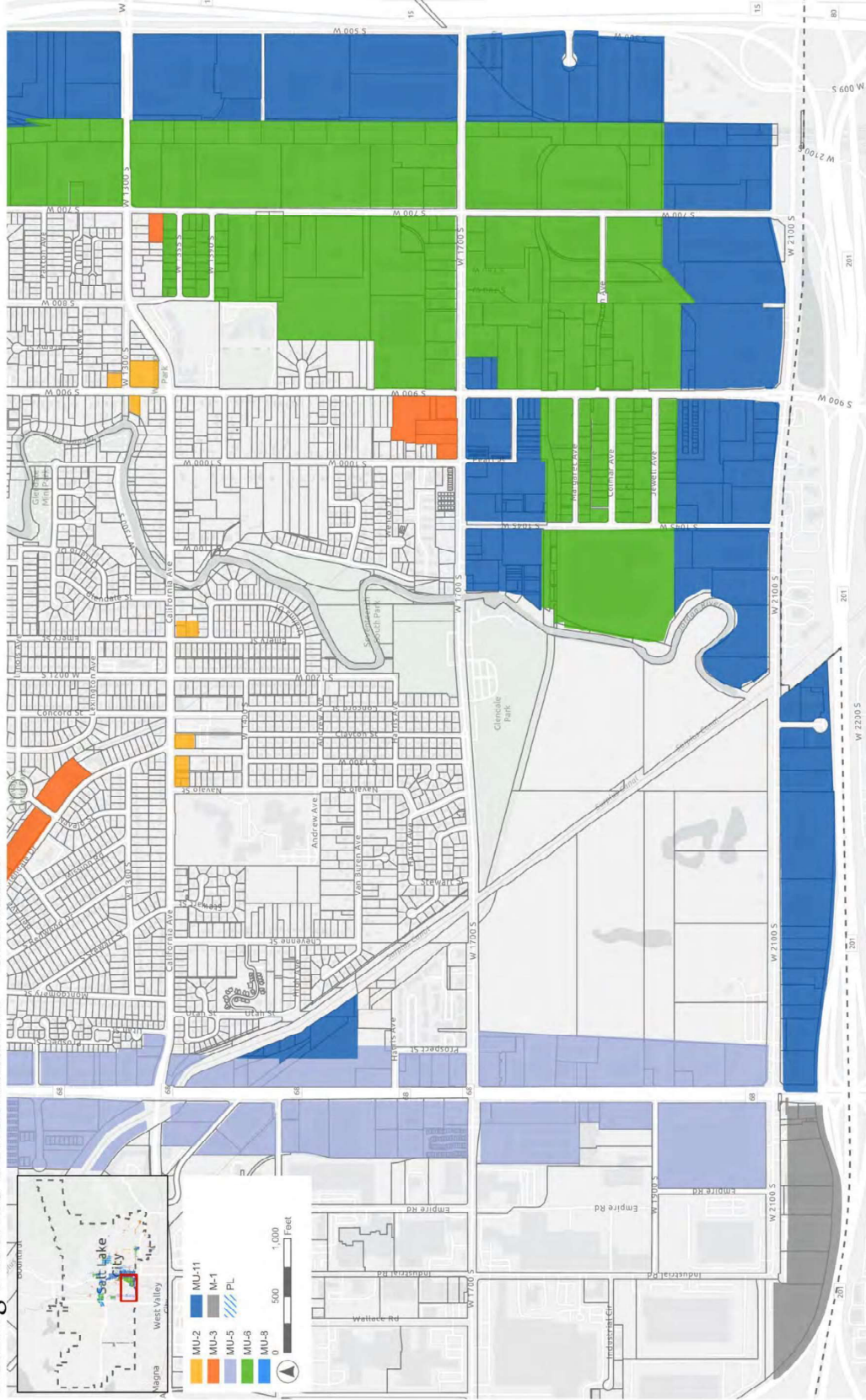




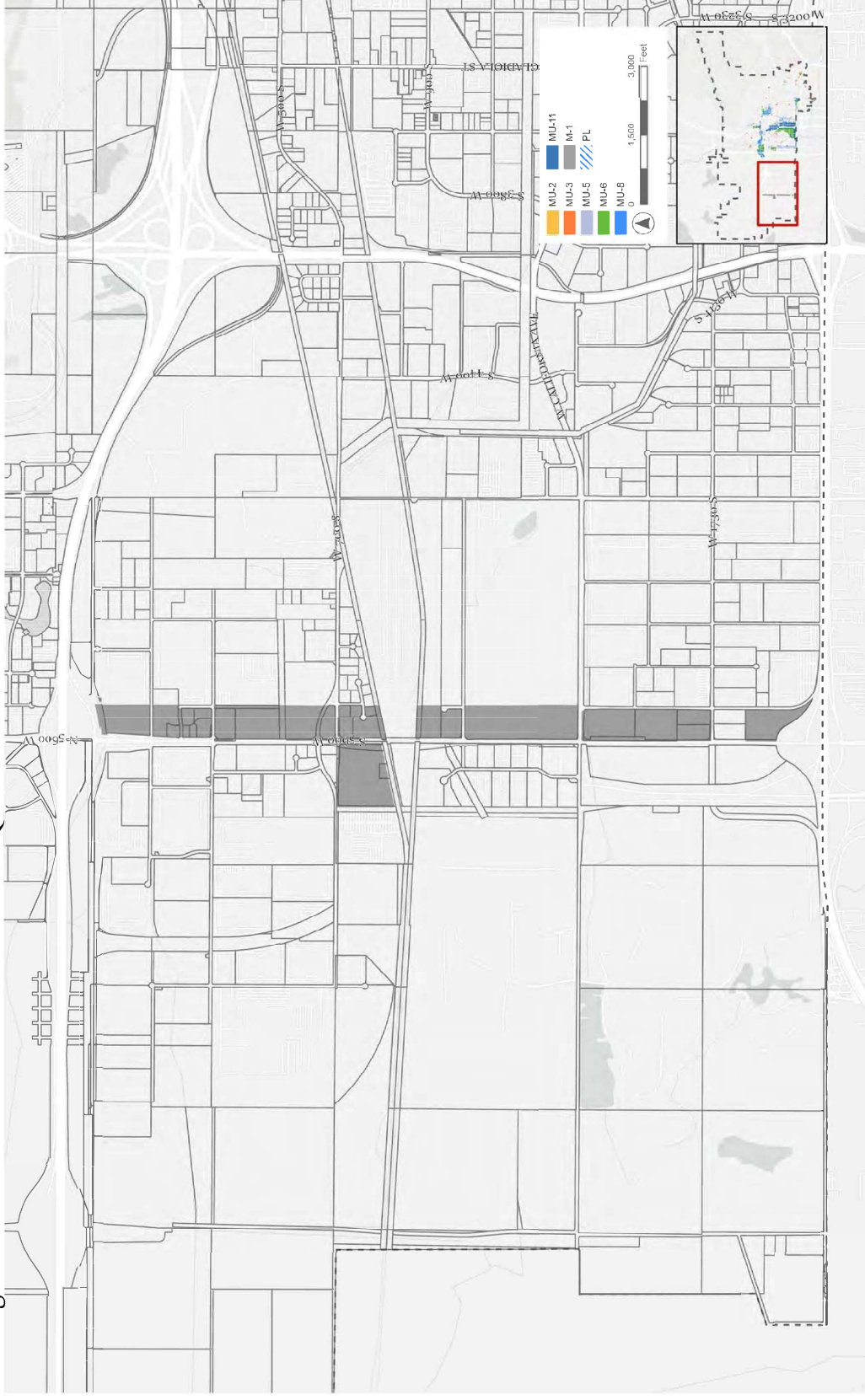
Zoning District Consolidation - Marmalade + Capitol Hill



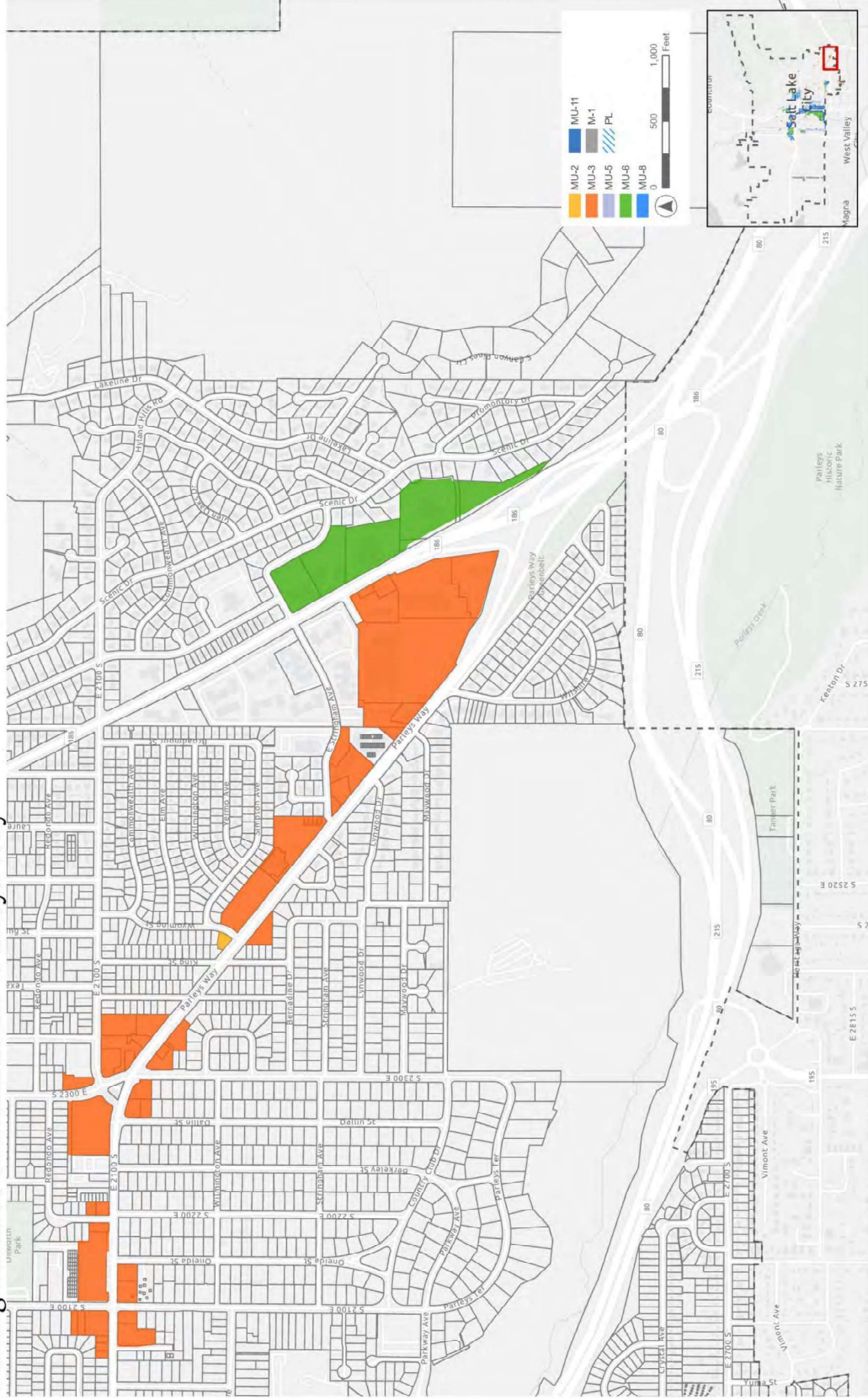


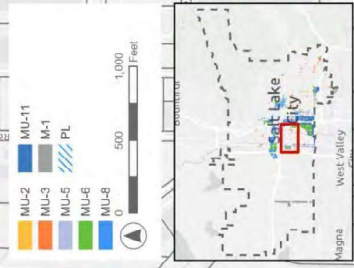


Zoning District Consolidation - Northwest Quadrant

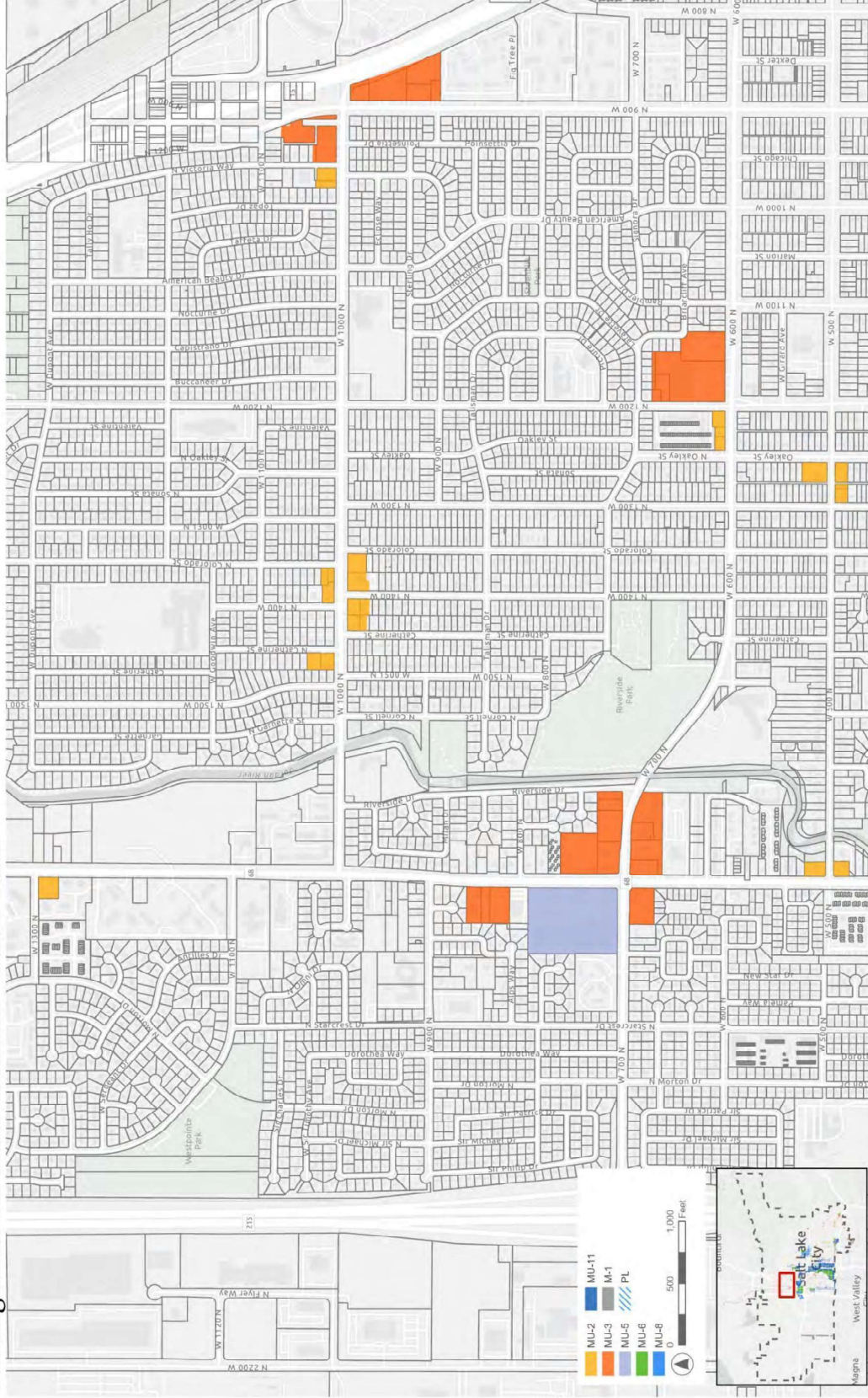


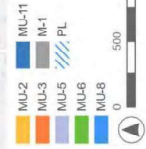

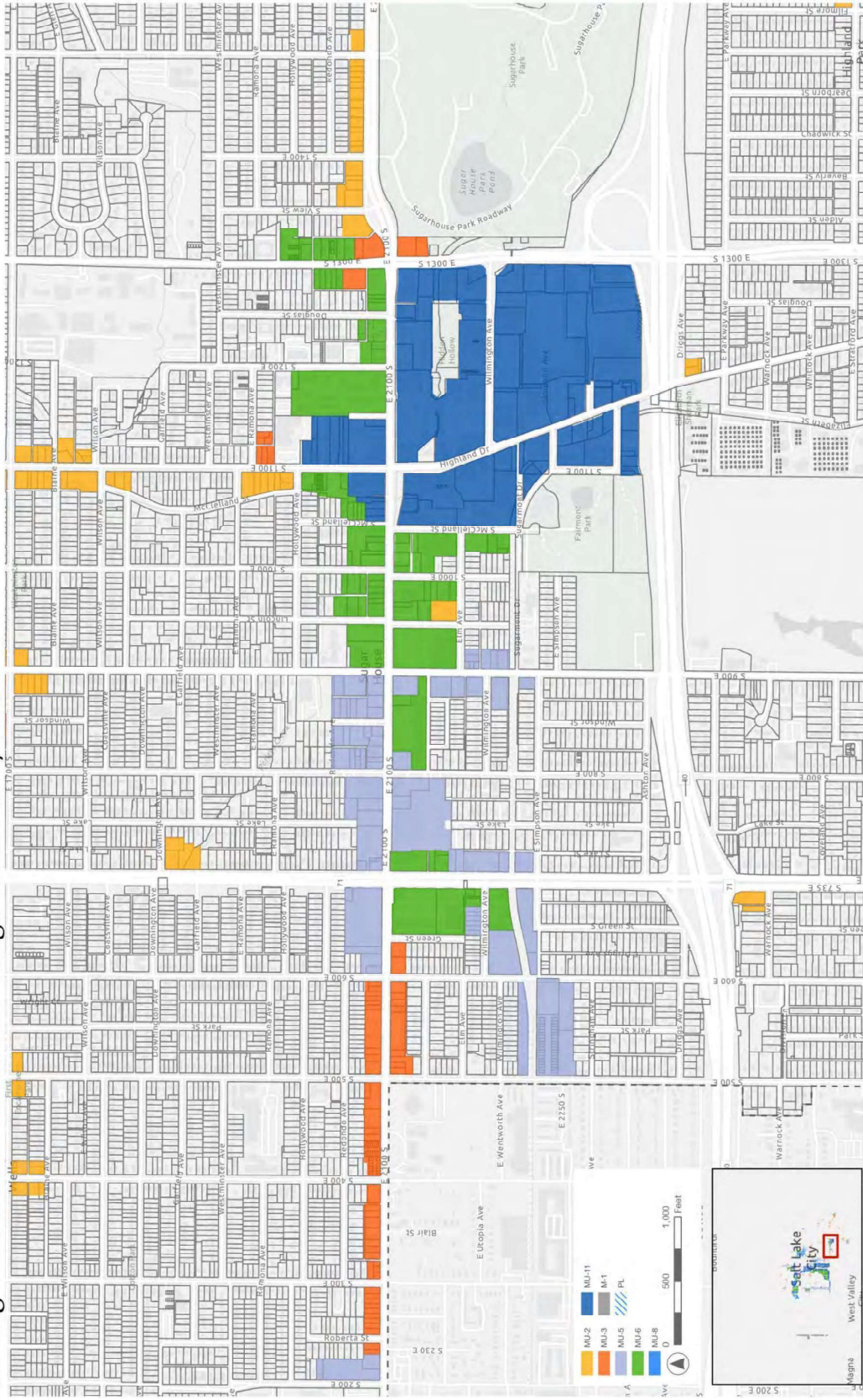

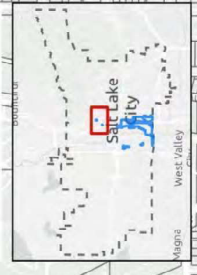
