**Legislative Action: Legislative Action: Amend city ordinance for the amount of time a reconstructed historic buildings is protected from 25 to 50 years.**

### Issue Summary

The council will consider adopting a legislative action that would initiate a zoning petition for city staff to research and draft an ordinance that would change the years a reconstructed historic building must be protected to 50 years (from 25).

On April 16 the Council adopted an ordinance that set the years at 25. It was published before the next formal meeting. Council Member Wharton wanted to change the ordinance to make it 50 years and intended to recall the vote on May 7. However, since the ordinance was published, that is not an option. So, the Council would need to adopt a legislative action initiating the process for this zoning change to be made.

If the Council supports this action, it may consider formally adopting the legislative action in the May 7 formal meeting.

### Motion to Initiate Legislative Action

I move the Council initiate a legislative action starting the process for city staff to research and draft an ordinance that would initiate a zoning petition to change the years a reconstructed historic building must be protected to 50 years (from 25).
