GRANT DETAILS:

The Salt Lake City Police Department applied to the COPS Hiring grant program for partial funding to hire 10 new police officers. The maximum federal share is \$125,000 per position for the 36-month project period. If awarded, the new police officers will be assigned to the Patrol Division, and the department will deploy 10 experienced, locally funded officers to newly created Intelligence-led Policing squads that will focus on addressing emerging violent crime issues and repeat violent crime offenders in Salt Lake City.

- 36 month project period: 10/1/20 – 9/30/23
- 12-month retention requirement for each officer position funded
- Does not include costs outside entry level salary and fringe (uniforms, cars, equipment, required training etc.)
- May not reduce existing current fiscal year budget for officers or FTEs to take advantage of the award
