DATA DOWNLOAD

- We have had a total of 486 guests stay at our Q&I facilities.
- Of total hospitalized, 25/295; 8.5% are persons experiencing homelessness.
- Of those currently hospitalized, 4/51; 7.8% are persons experiencing homelessness.

GENERAL UPDATES

- We have tested a total of 930 individuals.
- Enhanced testing continues in all Homeless Resource Centers.
- The Midvale Family Resource Center is again accepting new clients.

PARTNERS IN RESPONSE

- Any client who has a pet and is going to stay in a Salt Lake County quarantine and isolation facility does not have to worry about their animal being cared for. Through partnerships, Salt Lake County will make sure the pet is housed and reunited with its owner when they leave the facility.
- The Medical Reserve Corps has been instrumental in working with the Salt Lake County Health Department to make enhanced testing possible within the Homeless Resource Centers.

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
