- 1) Any Salt Lake County Health Immunization Clinic – make an appointment by calling 385-468-SHOT
- 2) Any CNS Mass Vaccination Location – CNS serves Salt Lake City at its 2830 S Redwood Road location.
- 3) Your local pharmacy or private provider – visit vaccine.gov to find a location or provider near you.

Additional information:

- There is no cost to get vaccinated.
- People under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a guardian at their appointment.

Jan 30- Feb 3, 2023

Homeless Resource Centers	96.8%
HRC Overflow "Flex" Beds	95.7%
Millcreek Overflow	87.6%
St. Vincent de Paul Overflow	98.5%

Average open beds/ night: 46/ 1063

This does not include all potential increased capacity with Mayor's emergency order (88 beds).

Homelessness Update

Rapid Intervention/ EIM

- HEART is tracking 43 locations with outreach or plans to address 36 sites
- EIM planned for 200 S 1200 W-Redwood Rd
- RIT locations:
 - VOA Outreach Engagement: 8
 - RIT Site Rehabilitations: 10
 - Recurring Cleanings: 18
