What we are hearing

- North Temple seems to lack a unified economic vision
- Several plans for the area exist, but are not economic development plans, are outdated, or have not seen enough progress to satisfy the community
- Safety concerns and blight on North Temple have been an ongoing concern expressed by businesses, organizations, and residents



About the grant

- The Department of Economic Development (DED) would like to lead the development and implementation of an Economic Revitalization Plan for North Temple.
- The Wasatch Front Regional Council has awarded DED \$170,000, to be matched with \$20,000 from the City, to begin work on this plan.
- DED will hire a consultant to conduct the community engagement and completion of this plan.
- The area we plan to address is North temple, between I-15 and I-215

Primary scope of work items

- Community and business engagement to assess community goals
- Asset and gap analysis of economic opportunities and activation
- Incorporate relevant insights from current and older North Temple area plans, and define DED's place in the efforts. Plans include:
 1. 2023 Thriving in Place
 2. 2014 Westside Master Plan (20 year plan)
 3. 2010 North Temple Boulevard Plan
 4. 2005 North Temple Corridor Economic Revitalization Plan
- Produce a North Temple Economic Revitalization Action Plan



Activation

- Initial meeting with NeighborWorks
- Currently DED & Public Lands are working with NeighborWorks to bring together coalition of partners
- Two 2023 events:
 - Mid-June, in conjunction with International Market, 1-2 movies (families & adults)
 - Early September, details TBD
